Boomi is a small town situated approx. 90 km north of the regional centre of Moree NSW and 92km south west of Goondiwindi QLD, accessed by bitumen sealed roads.

Boomi has a current population of approx. 200 people. Though small, this friendly town boasts a public school to yr 12, community hall, tennis club with 5 all-weather courts and police station. A camp draft is held annually at the end of July and large crowds arrive for the October long weekend annual Australian Championship Mud Trials (involving driving backyard bombs through several large mud puddles). Boomi also has an amateur thespian society (BATS) who stage a locally written production. This is held every two years at the end of August and is attended by approx. 700 people over four nights.

Boomi is a farming community; the main industries in the area are irrigated cotton, dryland farming (wheat, barley, and chickpeas), cattle and sheep production. Often providing many seasonal workers to assist on farm, adding to the drinking population.

Boomi is known for its Artesian hot baths, drawing people from near and far to enjoy the pure underground Artesian water and relax by the pools in the Baths complex.

This secure investment is underpinned by asset value, making this a low-risk purchase. The opportunity exists for a motivated operator to extend the business through further promotions and outback tourism.
